program at Bangladesh Health  
Professions Institute (BHPI), CRP  
under the project of  
“Regional Inter-professional  
Master’s program in  
Rehabilitation Science”  
funded by SAARC Development  
Fund (SDF).**

This is a 2 year full time international program, affiliated by Faculty of Medicine, University of Dhaka, Bangladesh. Students from the member countries of SAARC (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka) are expected to participate in this course.

## Objectives of M.Sc in Rehabilitation Science program:

1. To build the health and rehabilitation human resources for services, education, policy and research through development of capacity.
2. To create a cadre of leaders capable of advancing education, research and practice in the field of disability and rehabilitation science in Bangladesh and participating countries.

## Why should you study in this program?

- 1) New program: Students from diverse disciplinary and professional backgrounds will study together providing opportunity for inter-disciplinary collaborative learning.





- 2) **Scholarships:** 12 (40%) students from Bangladesh and 18 (60%) students from the remaining member countries of SAARC will be eligible for scholarships. The scholarships for Bangladeshi students will cover 82% of academic cost whereas the scholarship for the students of remaining member countries of SAARC will cover full academic cost, hostel charge, food cost and Dhaka University registration fee.
- 3) **Overseas and local faculty members:** Teaching will be conducted by the faculty members from overseas (The Queens University, Canada and Duke University, USA) and local Universities/ Institutes .
- 4) **A unique resource center:** CRP is one of the largest spinal injury rehabilitation centers in South Asia providing comprehensive rehabilitation services for neurologically impaired patients with emphasis on Spinal Cord Injury (SCI), orthopedics & musculoskeletal conditions and childhood disabilities at both institution based and community based services following a Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) approach.

Candidates with a Bachelor Degree in Physiotherapy / Occupational Therapy / Speech and Language Therapy or an equivalent degree related to health from the Public University or recognised by the concerned Government authority and completed one year internship training/working experience in any recognised hospital approved by the concerned Authority are eligible to apply for the program.

**Application deadline: May 25, 2017**

- Academia (research and teaching),
- Work with professional agencies and/or funding agencies
- Government agencies working on public health policy
- Program development at the local, national or international level
- International community-based rehabilitation
